## **Activities and Student Involvement**

In 2014-15 a large group of students participated in various International, National and State Level Competitions and exposed to hard test of intelligence and skills.

More than **175** ILS students represented ILS Law College as speakers, researchers and participants in **54** Moot Court Competitions (including one competition outside India) **3** Trial Competitions, **2** Client Counseling Competitions, **2** Negotiation, 1Drafting Competition, **1** Judgment Deliberation Competitions, **1** Legal research Paper Competition, **1** Power Point Presentation Competition, **4** Law Fests. **15** students gave support for research.

The number of students participating in various competitions and selections held in college was as follows:

More than 38 students drafted well-balanced problems for various intra-college moot and trial competitions.

Senior students and especially senior mooters very enthusiastically encouraged, supported and guided all moot court teams, and judged preliminary rounds of competitions. More than 80 students assisted in co-ordination and organization of all moot court competitions and selections.

The College organized a national-level Professor S P Sathe Memorial National Moot Court Competition in February.

Dr. Deepa Paturkar organised and co-ordinated these activities this year and guided teams participating in all competitions. Smt Ujjwala Sakhalkar organised the international law moots selections and team co-ordination and the Public International Law Competition. Dr. Deepa Paturkar along with Prof. Banu Vasudevan coordinated the Novices Moot-Court Competition. Dr Tejaswini Malagaonkar coordinated the Negotiation Challenge, Trial Advocacy Moot Court Competition and Counseling competition. Mrs. Sathya Narayan, Director, Institute of Advance Legal Studies coordinated the Prof S P Sathe Memorial National Moot Court Competition. All teachers very willingly judged competitions and guided ILS teams. Library and administrative staff gave enthusiastic support.

### **Raghavendra Phadnis Moot Court Competition**

The Raghavendra Phadnis Moot Court Competition 2014 was conducted over the course of 3 days. The preliminary rounds, which saw a total of 27 court rooms, and 290 odd participants, were held on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2014. The preliminary round had 5 problems, a labour problem drafted by Dr. Deepa Paturkar, an Arbitration problem drafted by Pooja Gera, a Constitution law problem drafted by Shakul Ghatole, a Contracts law problem drafted by Sujay Prasanna and a Tort law problem drafted by Harshavardhan Ganesan. Extensive orientations regarding the problems, as well as a demo moot was also conducted. Over 40 judges, consisting of ILS alumni as well as distinguished lawyers, attended the preliminary rounds. Two individuals per court room qualified to the semi-finals, which were held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of August, 2014. The cases for the semi-finals consisted of either Land laws or Intellectual Property law. For the semi-finals, there were four courtrooms, two for Intellectual Property and two for Land Laws.

The top three individuals per courtroom qualified for the finals which were held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of August 2014. Therefore, the finals had 12 participants, equally from Land Laws as well as IPR. The judges for the finals were Mr. Bhushan Panse, Advocate and Mr. Anand Deshpande, Senior Counsel, Cognizant Technologies.

The winner of the Raghavendra Phadnis Moot Court Competition was Namrata Nambiyar, with Akhila Palem coming a close second.

### **10<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL PUBLIC INTERNATIONAL LAW MOOT COURT COMPETITION Faculty Co-ordinator- Smt. Ujjwala Sakhalkar, Assistant Professor**

The 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Public International Law moot court competition 2014-2015 was conducted from 8<sup>th</sup> of February 2015 to 10<sup>th</sup> of February 2015. The theme for this year's competition was "statehood, secession and aggression"

The problem was drafted by Thulasi K. Raj (V B.S.L LL.B). This year's moot problem concerned the issues of state secession, statehood and unilateral declaration of independence. The conflict was between the principle of territorial integrity and self determination. It also addressed certain aspects of aggression.

Forty eight teams had participated from I and II B.S.L- LL.B and I LL.B. The preliminary rounds and semi final rounds were judged by Dr. Sanjay Jain, Dr. Tejaswini Malegaonkar, Ms. Mukta Mane and Ms Priya Sondhi. The final round of the competition was judged by Mrs. Prabhavati Bhaskey, Asst. Professor, Modern Law College, Pune, Mrs. Nalini Ambad, Asst. Professor, DES Law College, Pune, and Mrs. Vaishali Jadhav, Asst. Professor, Yashwant Rao Chavan Law College, Pune.

Ms. Harini Sutaria, Mr. Junaid Liani, Mr. Awani Kelkar of III BSL were the winners. Ms. Tulika Gupta and Ms. Arati Ranade were the Runners-up.

### **Selection Round for Public International Law Moots**

The Public International Law Selection Round 2014-15 was conducted on 8<sup>th</sup> of August 2014.

23 teams participated from III, IV and V B.S.L- LL.B and II and III LL.B. The competition was judged by Ms. Neha Pimpalwar, Mr. Prashant Gaikwad, Mrs. Tejaswini Malegaonkar and Ms. Rajlakshmi Joshi, Faculty of ILS Law College, Pune. Based on their scores, students were allotted national and State level competitions based on Public International Law.

Prof. Ujjwala Sakhalkar coordinated and organized this event.

## **Novices' Moot Court Competition**

The Novices' Moot Court Competition was organised in three rounds on 23rd and 24th January 2015 and 31st January 2015 for the youngest batch – mooters from I BA LLB and I LLB.

209 students participated in preliminary round on 23rd January arguing according to their choice four cases relating to (i) Law of Contract (ii) Law of Tort (iii) Law of Crimes and (iv) Constitutional Law in the preliminary round and semi-final round and on Law of Intellectual Property in the Final Round. The problems were formulated by Samyukta Balaji (V BSL LLB), Parashuram Sastry (V BSL LLB), Gunika Gupta (V BSL LLB), Swarnima Pandit & Deeksha Katarki (II BSL LLB) and Ritvik Kulkarni and Yojit Pareek (III BSL LLB). The drafters conducted the orientation on moot problems.

### **5th ILS Intra College Trial Advocacy Competition, 2014**

The 5<sup>th</sup> Intra College Trial Advocacy Competition was held on the 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2014. The problem was based on Law of Crimes and the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances and was drafted by Shakul Ghatole, Samyuktha Balaji, Senjuti Mallick, Divita Pagey, Disha Jham and Akhilesh Jaiswal. The Competition received an enthusiastic response from around 150 students, as witnesses, who induced life into the various characters involved in the problem.

Like the previous year, the competition received participation of 48 teams comprising of 192 participants. The preliminary round conducted on 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2014, was judged by various practicing advocates from the Sessions Court, Pune and Mumbai. One team from each of the 8 courtrooms qualified to the semi-finals which were held on 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 and further 2 teams qualified to the final round, held on 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2014.

The final round was judged by Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.R.Gavai, Bombay High Court and Mr. Rajesh Tiwari, District and Additional Sessions Judge, Sessions Court, Pune. The team comprising of Manav Gecil Thomas, Meghna Malhotra, Rishabh Malaviya and Tanya Singh were declared as winners. The runners up team comprised of Nikita Panse, Ritwik Kulkarni, Aishwarya Bedekar and Sairuchita Chowdhary. The event was co-ordinated by Dr. Tejaswini S. Malegaonkar.

### **The 3rd Intra-College Negotiation Challenge, 2014**

The Intra-College Negotiation Challenge, 2014, the Negotiation Competition, was conducted in two rounds on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. 36 teams of two members each participated in the preliminary rounds. For the first time, the students of Second BSL LLB were allowed to participate in this competition and there were 6 teams from second year participated.

Orientation and Demonstration: The orientation and demonstration for 'The 3<sup>rd</sup> Intra-College Negotiation Challenge, 2014' was held on 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. Mohona Thakur and Sushant Mahajan in one team and Ritika Chatterjee and Apoorva Katpatal in the other team demonstrated and discussed techniques of negotiation. Advocate Shrikant Malegaonkar (Member of Faculty, ILS Law College) discussed various techniques used for negotiating a case.

The Preliminary Round: 36 teams of two members each participated in the preliminary rounds of the competition held on 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2014, in six conference rooms. Separate sets of a problem and confidential information were created for the preliminary round and the final round by Rishabh Malaviya (3<sup>rd</sup> BSL LLB), Mohona Thakur and Apoorva Katpatal (4<sup>th</sup> BSL LLB), Arnavi Panda, Kshitij Deo, Shakul Ghatole and Pranay Jain (5<sup>th</sup> BSL LLB). Judges in the preliminary round were- Smt. Saritha Iyer (Country Finance Head, Inteva Products Pvt. Ltd.), Shri. Mihir Raje, Shri. Rajesh Shah, shri. Six teams went to the final round.

The Final Round: The final round was held on 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. The six teams selected in the preliminary rounds were divided into three slots. The judges for this round were Smt. Percis Ankleseria (Partner, AZB Pune) and Shri. Anant Bapat (General Manager- Operations, JCB, India). The competition was coordinated by Dr. Tejaswini Malegaonkar.

## **2nd ILS Intra College Client Counseling Competition, 2014**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> ILS INTRA COLLEGE CLIENT CONSULTATION was organized in ILS Law College, on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2014.

Students from III-V BSL and II-III LLB were eligible to participate as Attorneys and students of I – II BSL and I LLB were eligible to participate as Clients. The Orientation for the Competition was conducted by Dr. Nilima Bhadbhade. The entire Competition was coordinated by Dr. Tejaswini Malegaonkar and Dr. Deepa Paturkar. The Competition witnessed participation from students from all batches in huge numbers with 36 teams (each comprising of 2 members), 48 clients and 12 volunteers, the efforts of each one of them culminated into making the event a huge success.

The competition was divided into 3 rounds; Preliminary, Semi-Finals and Finals. The Preliminary rounds comprised of 9 chambers with 4 teams in each chamber. The attorneys dealt with issues based on Law of Contracts, Law of Torts and Family law. The Preliminary round was judged by Advocates - Shri. Rajesh Shah, Shri. The highest scoring team from each chamber of Preliminary Rounds advanced to the Semi-Finals which had 3 chambers, each consisting of 3 teams. The problem for the Semi- Finals was based on Criminal Law. It was judged by Adv. Rohit Tulpule, Adv. Rishiraj, Adv. Santosh Bhagwat, Adv. L.D.S. Bohite, Adv. Prasad Kulkarni and Dr. Tejaswini Malegaonkar. The team with the highest score from each chamber qualified for the final showdown.

Three teams qualified to the finals, each one of them were seen counseling clients relating to issues regarding Intellectual Property Laws. The Finals was judged by Dr. Nilima Bhadbhade and Ms. Priyanka Kulkarni.

### **Moot Court Society of ILS Law College**

The Moot Court Society or MCS as it is fondly called has established itself as a dominant cell in its first year of inception. The inauguration session was conducted by Harshavardhan Ganesan, Arnavi Panda and Dr. Deepa Paturkar, the faculty co-ordinator. The inauguration session alone attracted more than 200 students. The students were oriented as to the functioning of the society, including weekly moot sessions, memo formatting workshops, as well as compulsory oral rounds before any moot representing college. The Core-committee of the MCS consisting of 12 members was also decided, which includes representatives from

all the years, to make mooting more democratic. The Moot Court Society met every Tuesday, with an average strength of about 100 students for every session, which included a considerable amount of first and second years. Mainly, the MCS has integrated the first years into the mix, by conducting sessions on drafting issues, basic argumentation, how to research for a moot etc. The MCS has also conducted orientations with regards various provisions of procedural law, such as evidence, CPC, CrPc etc. Further, a 2 day thorough memo formatting workshop was conducted by Sharanya Kundu, which was widely attended by students. Apart from which, the MCS has co-ordinated with the corporate law cell for the purposes of giving an orientation for the extempore moot court competition. Apart from which, the Core-committee of the MCS has been actively involved in conducting compulsory oral presentations, for those students representing ILS in moots outside college. This has led to outstanding results thus far.

The MCS has also been pivotal in holding multiple demo moots as well as other MCS related workshops.
