Instructions for sending submissions to Abhivyakti Literary Magazine 2021

Content Policy for the Magazine:

- Co-authorship is allowed to a maximum of two authors.
- The language of the submissions should be English, though the Author(s) may choose to review works or provide references to content published in other languages.
- The submission can be made under the following categories:
 - Essays (Maximum 3000 words)
 - Poetry (Maximum 1500 words)
 - Stories (Maximum 3000 words)
 - Literary Reviews [books, movies, etc.] (Maximum 1500 words)
 - One Act Plays (Maximum 3000 words)

The word limit may be relaxed only in exceptional cases depending upon the quality of the submission.

• For references, if required, an appropriate hyperlink should be provided in the main text itself. However, if your submission contains sources that cannot be linked, the use of footnotes is allowed.

Formatting and Submissions Guidelines:

- The submissions should be in a uniform Times New Roman font (body: size 12, heading: size 14, line spacing: 1.50, para spacing: 6, and justified alignment; footnotes, if included: size 10 and line spacing: 1).
- Submissions should be made in electronic format, particularly in the Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx) format at https://forms.gle/LsNUvVExKCGowzE97.
- Multiple submissions per author are allowed. However, separate forms need to be submitted for individual submissions.
- To upload your submission document, fill the form > click on "add file" option at the

bottom of the form > click on upload > click on "select files from your device" > browse to the file you want to upload > select it and click on open.

• You'll receive a confirmation once the form has been successfully submitted.

Review Process for the Submissions:

- Abhivyakti Literary Magazine follows a blind review process.
- More than 15% of plagiarism will result in summary rejection of the submission and the decision of the Editorial Board shall be final in this regard.
- Please note that the Editorial Board may suggest the Author(s) to undertake necessary changes/alterations which should be duly complied within a week, failing which, the Editorial Board will not be able to consider the submission for further processing.
- The content should be the original work of the Author(s) and should not have been submitted or be under consideration for any other competition or any publication.
- The authors are advised to avoid using language that is hateful, offensive, inflammatory, or provocative. In this regard, the decision of the faculty editors will be final and binding.
