Activities and Events Reports:

The activities conducted by Marathi Vaad Sabha can be broadly categorized into three parts viz. *Kaydyache Bola* (Advocacy-Related Sessions), *Swachchand* (Open Mic Sessions) and *Vaad-Vivad Satra* (Debate and Training Sessions).

1. Kaydyache Bola (Advocacy-Related Sessions)

This recently added segment of Vaad Sabha has the ultimate objective of exchanging opinions and conducting discussions on a variety of current socio-legal issues and imparting knowledge of Legal terms.

• **Title:** Marathi Moot Court

Date: July 25, 2023 **Mode:** Offline

Resource Person: Prashik Rakshe & Renuka Sulakhe (both V BA LLB)

No. of Participants: 10

Report: This session on Marathi Moot Court was arranged for the internal committee only. It was to decide the roadmap of upcoming activities, especially the Marathi Moot Court competition. Here, the general rules for mooting are discussed in simple Marathi language. A rulebook in Marathi with Devnagari script to be prepared was resolved.

• **Title:** Legal Terminologies **Date:** August 22, 2023

Report: This was a session on the usage of Legal Terminologies in Marathi Language. Reference was made to the Marathi Legal Dictionary. In this session, participants were informed about the Marathi Legal Dictionary available in our college library. This session also informed students about the importance of knowledge of the Marathi language and the use of appropriate terminologies for practicing advocates in Courts.

• **Title:** Discussion on LGBTQIA+ Community Rights

• Title: State-Level Marathi Elocution Competition

Date: February 20, 2024 **Level** – State Level

Judges: Dr. Swati Kulkarni and Dr. Neeta Bokil

No. of Participants: 50

Report: Marathi Vaad sabha on February 20, 2024 had successfully organized a State-Level Marathi Elocution Competition. 50 students from overall Maharashtra participated in this Competition. The topics for the elocution were as follows.
