#### Registration:

1. Eligibility: The Bill Analysis Competition is open only to students of II BA.LL.B, II BBA.LL.B and II LL.B.
2. The participation is restricted to 30 teams only. The registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.
3. The Team must comprise 3 students.
4. The language of the competition is English.
5. Once the analysis is submitted, no modification of any form shall be allowed.
6. Withdrawal of participation after 7th December 2024 will not be entertained and strict action will be taken if someone does not appear in the competition.

**General Rules:**

1. The Competition will be conducted in two phases:
  - a. Written submissions in Online mode (Soft Copy)
  - b. Presentation (Offline)
2. Each team will be required to submit a soft copy of the bill analysis. ONLY the teams qualifying for the final round will be eligible to make a Presentation.

**Written Submissions (Soft Copy):**

1. All written submissions are to be mailed to: **bhumika.rathod@ilslaw.in**
2. The written submissions of the Analysis must contain:
3. Cover Page (White) stating the name of the competition, team code, and the name of the Bill analysed.
4. Table of Contents.
5. Abstract of Analysis – not exceeding 200 words
6. Analysis – not exceeding 1200 words
7. Analysis must be inclusive of, but not limited to:
  - General Features of the Bill.
  - Relevance of the subject-matter
  - Current laws pertaining to it
  - Analysis of the proposed bill
  - Suggestions in that behalf
8. Parameters for marking:
  - Content

- Presentation
  - Critical Analysis
9. Format of Written Submission (Soft Copy):
- Font Type: Times New Roman
  - Font Size: 12
  - Line Spacing: 1.5
  - Headings: 14 (Bold)
  - 1” (2.54cm) margin on all sides.
  - Header stating the name of the competition and name of the Bill in Italics.
  - Page Numbers at the bottom, right-hand corner of the page.
  - Participants may follow any one *uniform* method of citation.
  - Appropriate references and end-notes must be included.

**Presentation:**

1. Each team will decide the conduct of the presentation.
2. Laptop and projector facilities shall be provided by the organizers.
3. Each team will be given a maximum of 15 minutes for the presentation.  
Each team shall be given 10 minutes to present their PowerPoint Presentation and 5 minutes for questions from the panel of judges.
4. Each team will be required to use the submitted PowerPoint Presentation.
5. Non-submission of the PowerPoint Presentation within the given time will lead to direct disqualification.
6. Parameters for marking:
  - Legal Analysis
  - Effectiveness of Presentation
  - Responses to judges’ queries
  - Overall Performance
