

To know the answers to this and other questions about elections and the proposed changes to how they occur, join us in our session on the one nation one election policy.





The much awaited judgment of the apex court in the matter of *Supriyo Vs. Union of India* aka the Marriage Equality Petition was pronounced this week.

All 5 judges unanimously held that no fundamental right to marry exists, thus dismissing the central prayer in the batch of petitions - further, the majority also held that no right of union could be construed by the courts and this was a matter best left to the competence of the legislature.



WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a '**SOVEREIGN, SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC**' and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;
LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;
EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all
FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the [unity and integrity of the Nation].

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949 do **HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.**

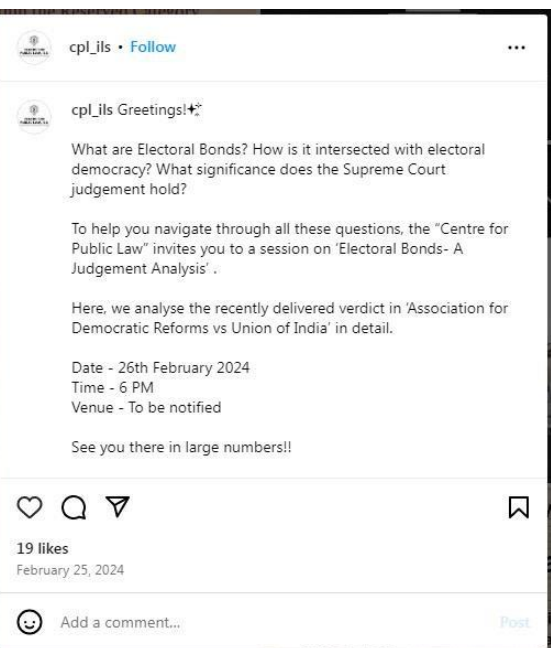
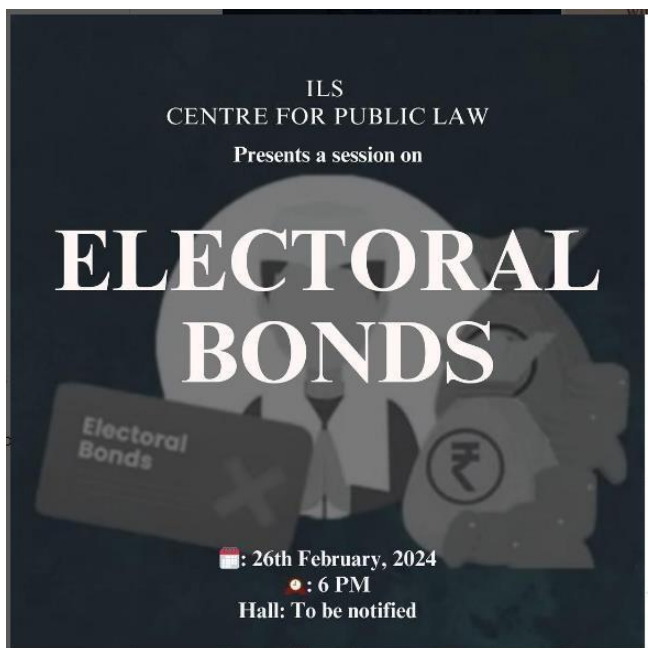
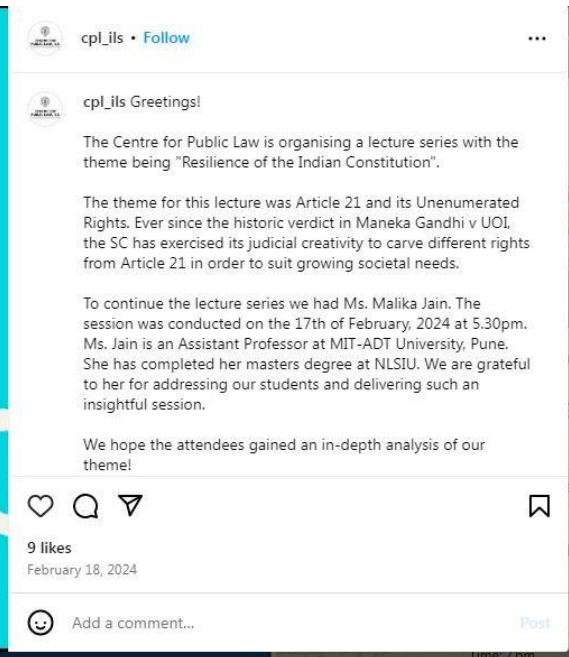
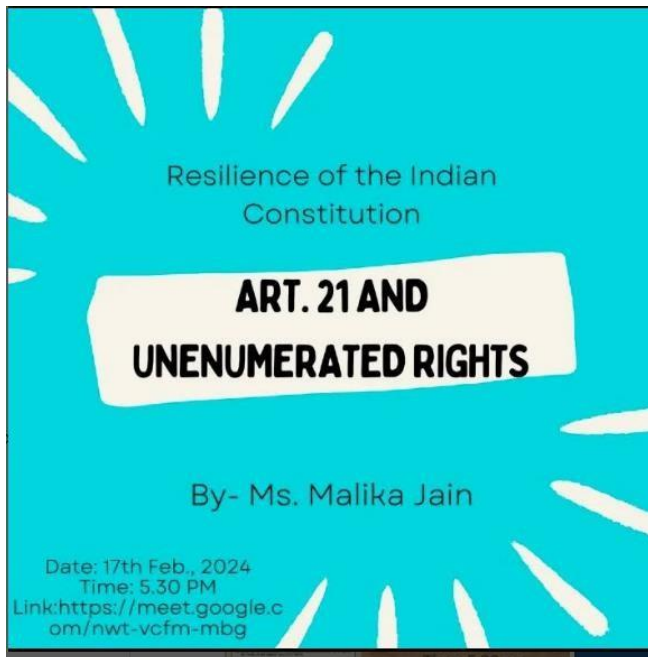
Amit sir is a founding member of the Public Law Centre. He had started the Centre with the help of Professors, 15 years back when he was in college.

We thank him wholeheartedly for taking out time for the session. We believe his discussion gave our students important insights into the theme of our lecture series.

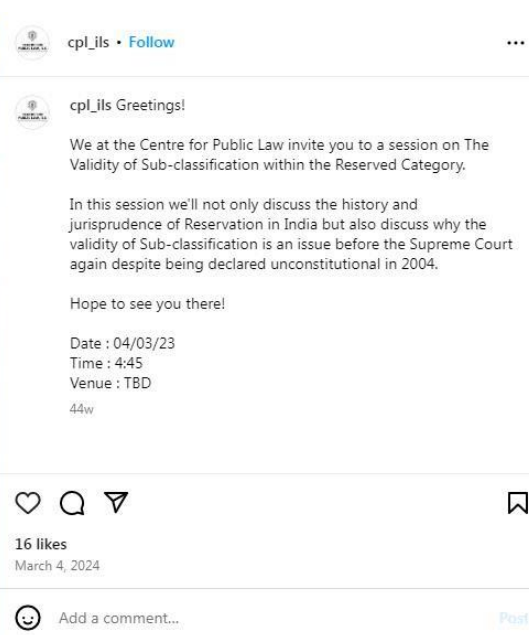
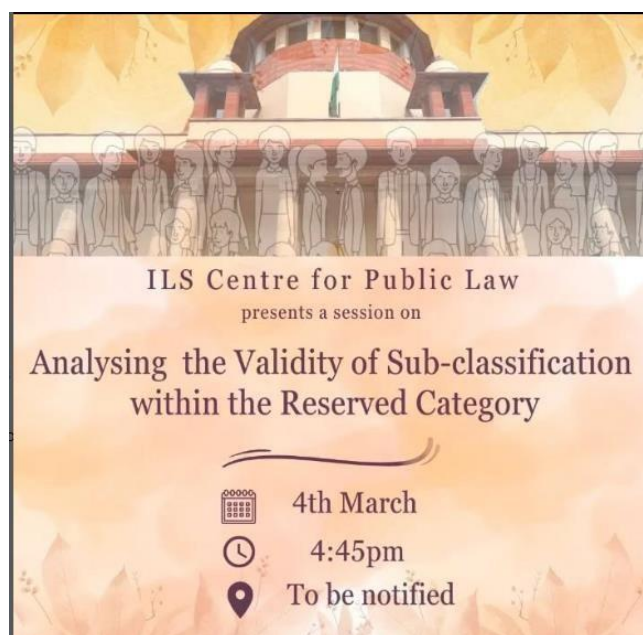
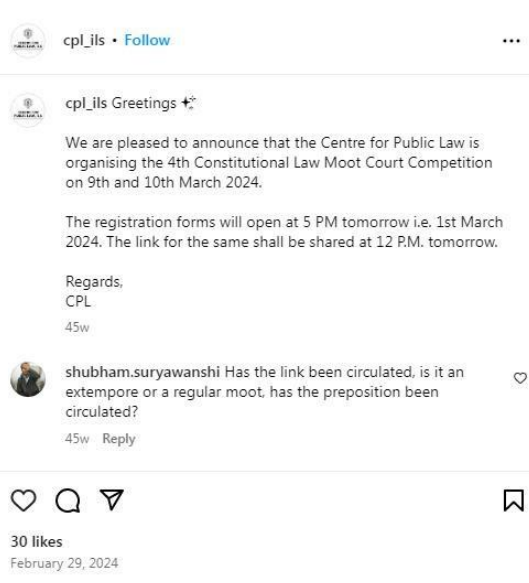
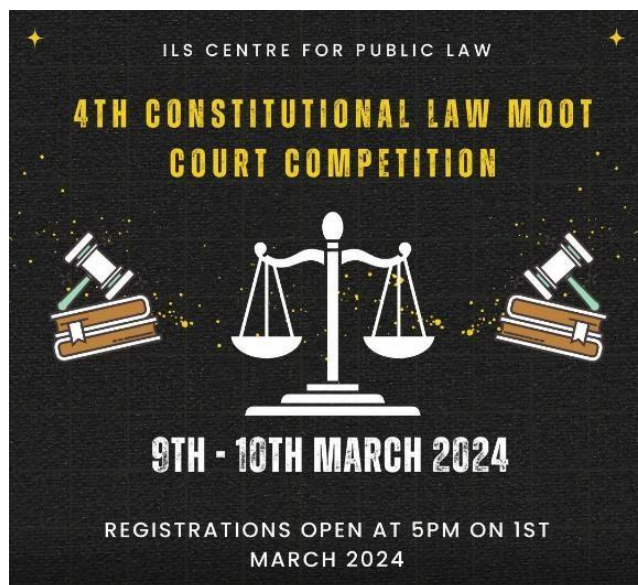
